Deuteronomy 4:1-2, 6-8: Moses emphasizes the Israelites' obedience to God's law. Israelites should diligently observe God's commandments, statutes, and decrees. By observing the law, they demonstrate their commitment to God and their faith.

James 1:17-18, 21-22, 27: God is the source of all good gifts. His gifts, including the Word of Truth, are perfect and unchanging. Embrace the Word of Truth with humility. Put the Word into practice, avoiding mere lip service. The Word of Truth must be received with humility and lived out in daily life. Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23 Pharisees question Jesus about the lack of handwashing among his disciples. Jesus addresses their concern by highlighting the difference between external practices and inner purity. Jesus explains that defilement comes from within, not external practices. Inner thoughts and intentions determine moral and spiritual purity. The Gospel gives a list of vices: Evil thoughts, unchastity, theft, murder, and other vices stem from within. These vices contaminate a person's heart and actions. Prioritize inner purity and the transformation of the heart. External practices are secondary to cultivating genuine moral and spiritual growth.
