CAROL ACUTIS: FIRST MILLENIAL SAINT - It is great news that Pope Francis has cleared the way for a London born teenager of Italian parents to become the first millennial saint by attributing a second miracle to him. The teenager is often called the patron saint of the internet among Roman Catholics because of his computer skills, which he used to share his faith. He died of leukaemia in 2006 when he was just 15. His passion for Catholicism bloomed early. At 7, he began attending daily Mass. His faith inspired his mother to rejoin the church. Carlo used his self-taught digital skills to create website archiving miracles. He also enjoyed playing soccer and video games. A great inspiration to the young people of this age.
