A LIFE WITH PURPOSE

St Paul, in the second reading is quite adamant in his condemnation of the kind of haphazard behaviour. "I want to urge you in the name of the Lord," he says, "not to go on living the aimless kind of life that pagans live." In other words, Christ must be seen to be a living influence in the lives of all his true followers. In the gospel, the people who followed Jesus were so enthusiastic about this sudden abundance of food he had provided that they decided to ensure its continuation and so set out to make Jesus their king. They were blind to the spiritual meaning of the miracle and the message Jesus drew from it. "Do not work for food that cannot last," he warned, "but work for food that endures to eternal life, the kind of food the Son of Man is offering you." With us too, it can happen that we are willing to follow Christ on our own conditions, namely, that he solve our immediate problems and grant our requests. We must seek him for himself, and not for what we can get from him.
