Mark 3: 20-35 Jesus accused as being possessed: Jesus has returned home. But his reputation precedes him. He has been driving out demons and curing people and when he arrives home, he is quickly surrounded by a crowd. People evidently find his remarkable works inexplicable and bizarre. Both Jesus's own relatives and those in the neighbourhood conclude that Christ is possessed by the "prince of demons" and that "he is out of his mind." His "mother and his brothers" arrive and try to speak to him, presumably to take him to safety or talk some sense into him. Christ's response to the crowd: Jesus responds not with anger or defensiveness, but with his skills as a storyteller and weaver of parables. He also relies on reason: "How can Satan drive out Satan? if Satan has risen up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand. "He speaks boldly — even shockingly — about what it means to be a member of his family. "Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother." The Takeaway: What matters ultimately to be a member of Jesus's "family" is to do the will of God
