This will take place at 5.30pm on Wednesday 13 November 2024 in the Chapel of the Holy Family in Hinsley Hall. At the same time as when the bishops will be at prayer, we shall hold a Holy Hour in our Church at St Joseph's for the intrinsic dignity of every person.
