REFLECTION

Today's readings are all to do with welcoming and discipleship. In our first reading Abraham welcomes the three men and offers to them the best hospitality he could provide without distractions. They turn out to be God's messengers and they richly bless Abraham and Sarah with the promise of a child which they have always wanted. In the second reading St Paul explains to the Colossian Christians that it was God's purpose all along to reveal his Son Jesus to the whole world. They are now to welcome him and live his way and so become the people God wants them to be. The Gospel reading is about Martha and Mary. They are both followers of Christ and welcome him with their best hospitality but do it in different ways: Mary by giving her full attention to Jesus, Martha by getting the meal ready. But Jesus has to remind Martha that discipleship must not be spoilt by self-concern and self-pity. Mary has chosen the better part by being totally committed to the way of Jesus. Martha needs to learn this way too. Jesus calls us to give of our best in following him but without worrying about the cares of this life.
