Invited to dine with Jesus

Psalm 34

In the first reading, we have this woman by the name of Wisdom. She builds herself a house, she throws a feast of fine wine and good meat and sends out her servants into the streets to say, 'Come and eat of my bread, drink the wine I have prepared.' This is echoed in the figure of Jesus in the gospel who declares, 'I am the living bread which has come down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will live forever.' Like Woman-Wisdom Jesus invites us to come and eat of his bread, but unlike Woman-Wisdom, he declares himself to be that bread. In language that is very daring Jesus declares himself to be our food and drink, the one who can satisfy our deepest hungers and thirsts. We come to the Eucharist hungering and thirsting for life, for authentic life, the life of God, the love of God, and we are sent out from the Eucharist as life givers, as agents of God's life and love within our homes, our society, our world.

BANNS OF MARRIAGE:

A serious obligation rests on everyone to reveal any known impediment to the proposed marriage. Therefore, if any of you know cause or just impediment why these persons should not be joined together in Holy Matrimony you are to declare it to either the parish priest of St Joseph's, Malvern, or to the Parish Priest of the Most Holy Trinity, Ledbury. This is the first time of asking.

BAPTISM AND CONFIRMATION: SUNDAY 25TH

AUGUST. Please pray for Isabella Hardley who will receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist and Sofia Hardley who will be baptised and receive Communion on Sunday 25th August at the 11AM Mass. These two have been part of the group that received sacraments of initiation last Easter.

The Second Collection this Sunday is for Leprosy -

Leprosy is a disease that affects the nerve endings in the hands and feet and can affect the blink reflex of the eye lids. If not treated early enough it can cause life-changing disabilities and even blindness. It costs Lepra £25 to change a life and if found early enough and treatment provided the disease can be halted preventing disability, but reconstruction surgery often restores the use of limbs and sight to both adults and children. Please always remember people with leprosy in your prayers.

FIRST CONFESSION AND HOLY COMMUNION PREPARATION -

If your child will be in year 3 or above in September and you consider that he or she is ready to begin preparation for this sacrament, please complete the application form (copies are on the parish website and in the Narthex) and either return to the parish or send to Carol Ann Harnett. The programme will start at the beginning of October.
