### Some truths are hard to hear

Jesus had something very important to say about what was about to happen to him. In the words of the gospel, he was telling them that he would find himself in the hands of others, who would put him to death. This was something that the disciples found very hard to hear and were not able to take on board. As the gospel says, 'they did not understand what he said, and they were afraid to ask him.' They did not understand it and they were reluctant to question him because they were afraid, they might not be able to live with the answers he would give them. In some ways that is a very human reaction. Have we ever been unwilling to ask questions because we suspected that we would struggle to live with the answers to our questions?
