COMING SOON: (THE NEW LECTIONARY) The new Lectionary will use the English Standard Version - Catholic Edition of the Bible and the Abbey Psalter. The changes are intended to make the biblical translations more faithful to the original languages, biblical scholarship, and to provide a text for use in liturgical setting that is more proclaimable and, where appropriate, more inclusive. It will become mandatory for use in all Catholic parishes and Mass centred in England and Wales and in Scotland from Advent 2024. We shall need to have the following editions for our parish: The Ambo Edition which comes in Four volumes for the lectern, the study version which will be portable for use in domestic, house or school Mass settings and the book of Gospels.
